Cape Carteret Boat Launch and Park Rules and Regulations

1. Hours of Operation: Open 24 hours and Decal Stickers are available at Town Hall M-F from 9 am - 5 pm.
2. Charges for Use:
 - a) **Town Residents** (Tax Paying Property Owners)
 1. **\$100.00** (from July 1, 2020 thru June 30, 2021)
 2. Receive up to 2 Decal Stickers and \$5.00 per each additional decal sticker
 3. Qualifications:
 - Vessel must be registered to a Resident or Property Owner of Cape Carteret
 - Children of Property Owner may receive the residential rate (*but must complete a separate application and pay their own \$100.00 fee*)
 - **A maximum of 4 passes allowed per resident**
 - b) **Local Non-Residents** (Cedar Point, Bogue, and Peletier Residents)
 - **\$200.00** (from July 1, 2020 thru June 30, 2021)
 - Receive only 1 Decal Sticker and \$5.00 per each additional decal sticker
 - **A maximum of 2 passes allowed per non-resident**
 - c) **Other** (Non-commercial)
 - **\$300.00** (from July 1, 2020 thru June 30, 2021)
 - Receive only 1 Decal Sticker and \$5.00 per each additional decal sticker
 - **A maximum of 2 passes allowed per non-resident**
1. The decal sticker must be placed on the **port side (left side)** of the winch post on the boat trailer. ** This is the opposite side than we have requested in years past.
2. Permits are **not transferable**, nor can they be used by anyone other than the registrant.
3. Persons using this facility do so at their own risk and should always be courteous to fellow boaters.
4. Anyone launching a boat or personal watercraft must be at least **16 years of age** and have a valid driver's License.
5. No dealer plates allowed.
6. Park only in designated areas. Violators will be ticketed.
7. All vehicles with trailers must be backed into spaces designated with curb markers. Vehicles may park on right-of-way (ROW), where designated. All vehicles parked in the right-of-way must have all wheels off of paved surface. Overnight parking in ROW is strictly prohibited.
8. **Use of this facility by commercial enterprise of any kind is prohibited.**
9. The following are ***expressly prohibited*** on the premises:
 - a. Unnecessarily loud or profane language
 - b. Roughhousing/rowdy behavior
 - c. Alcohol consumption
 - d. Littering
10. All federal, state, and local statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations pertaining to launching and operation of boats and personal watercraft must be observed.
11. The Town of Cape Carteret reserves the right to refuse service to anyone who violates these rules and regulations.
12. Federal, state, county, and municipal officials may use the ramp when engaged in their official duties.
13. July 20, 2009 the Board approved the following: No permits will be issued if outstanding taxes are owed.

14. **Penalty: Ordinance 95.02 (B2) includes boat ramp parking without a purchased pass: \$200 fine.**
Failure to display a paid annual pass: \$50.00 fine.
