The Town of Cape Carteret will begin picking up vegetative debris from Hurricane Dorian on Monday, September 16th. All vegetative debris needs to be in the right-of-way for pickup by sunrise on September 16th as the contractor will only be making one pass through the Town.

Please place vegetative debris piles neatly in the right-of-way and do not obstruct travel lanes. Please do not add any foreign objects such as household waste, treated wood, or plywood to the debris piles (these piles will not be picked up). Please try to avoid placing piles below power and cable lines as it makes it difficult for the contractor to get to the piles. The Town will not remove debris in front of vacant undeveloped lots or from commercial properties.

Please note that the Town is only picking up vegetative debris and no Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) will be picked up. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
