GLASS	All clear, brown and green glass containers	Remove lids and rinse bottles and jars. Paper labels are O.K. Place in bottom of bin.	No drinking glasses, mirror, light bulbs, window glass or dishes.
MIXED PLASTIC	All P.E.T. and H.D.P.E. containers. Look for a "1" or "2" on the bottom of the container.	Remove lids and neck rings. Labels O.K. Rinse and place in bottom of bin. May crush containers.	No plastic wrap, plastic bags, or plastic bottles that contain hazardous materials such as antifreeze or motor oil.
ALUMINUM & STEEL CANS	All beverages or food cans.	Rinse and place in bottom of bin. Cans may be crushed to conserve space.	No scrap metal, paint cans, aerosol cans, automotive product cans, aluminum foil or pie tins.
NEWSPAPERS	All newspaper and inserts.	Place on top of bin. Bundle, do not tie.	No catalogs or telephone books.
MAGAZINES	Magazines with slick, shiny pages not over 1/4 inch thick	Tie together or place in paper grocery bag and stack on top of bin.	No catalogs or telephone books.
MIXED PAPER	Junk Mail, stationary, non-window envelopes, shoe soap, cereal boxes, office paper and computer paper.	Tie together or place in paper grocery bag and stack on top of bin.	No paper with glue, wax or oil. No catalogs or telephone books.
