Request for Proposals (RFP)

Cape Carteret Fall 2020 Paving Project

Project Scope

The Town of Cape Carteret is soliciting proposals for the resurfacing of several roads located within the Town of Cape Carteret. The Town expects the selected contractor to perform the following functions and tasks in order to successfully complete this project:

- Cut out areas that are not suitable for overlay and install ABC stone to establish or stabilize the road base as needed – *the Town shall only be billed for the amount of ABC stone that is installed; the billing rate shall be at the rate specified in the proposal from the contractor*
- Install 1.5" of asphalt overlay
- All work must be performed in accordance with industry standards
- Traffic control measures must be provided at all times in accordance with industry standards to ensure the safe movement of pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists in the project areas
- The contractor shall cut out or mill the ends of each paving area to tie the new asphalt into the existing asphalt
