



## Town of Cape Carteret Accepting Applications from Residents Interested in Serving on Park Improvements Committee

The Board of Commissioners has established a new, ad hoc committee to consider and recommend park improvements in the Town, and is currently soliciting Town residents to serve on this committee. The new committee is expected to begin meeting this spring, and will identify desired park improvements at the Town's 4 non-waterfront parks (Community Park, Bahia Lane Park, Quailwood Park, and Taylor Notion Road Park), identify neighborhood concerns and develop recommendations that will be supported by the neighborhood in which any new park improvements would be installed, and also identify any existing vacant parcels of land that the Town should consider acquiring for future park development. The committee will include a total of 8 members, as follows:

- 1 member of the Board of Commissioners,
- 2 members of the Planning Board,
- 1 representative from the Star Hill North property owners association,
- 1 additional representative who resides in the Star Hill North neighborhood,
- 1 representative from the Star Hill property owners association, and
- 2 residents of other neighborhoods in Cape Carteret.

The Board of Commissioners is expected to appoint the committee members at its March 13 regular meeting.
