



Cape Carteret Boat Launch and Park Rules and Regulations 2022-2023

1. Hours of Operation Boat Ramp: Open 24 hours a day 7 days a week
2. Decal Stickers are available at Town Hall M-F from 9 am - 5 pm. Residents of the Town of Cape Carteret can purchase 2022-2023 passes beginning June 20, 2022. Boat Ramp passes will be capped at 285 passes for the year 2022-2023. If still available, all others can purchase 2022-2023 passes beginning July 1, 2022.

3. Charges for Use:

a) **Town Residents** (Tax Paying Property Owners)

1. **\$225.00** (from July 1, 2022, thru June 30, 2023) receive **1** Decal Sticker
2. **\$50.00** per one additional decal sticker.

3. Qualifications:

- Vessel must be registered to a Resident or Property Owner of Cape Carteret
- Children of Property Owner may receive the residential rate (*but must complete a separate application and pay their own **\$225.00** fee*)
- **A maximum of 2 passes allowed per resident.**

b) **Local Non-Residents** (Cedar Point, Bogue, and Peletier Residents)

- **\$500.00** (from July 1, 2022 thru June 30, 2023) receive only 1 Decal Sticker
- **A maximum of 1 pass allowed per non-resident.**

c) **Other** (Non-commercial)

- **\$750.00** (from July 1, 2022 thru June 30, 2023) receive only 1 Decal Sticker
- **A maximum of 1 pass allowed per non-resident.**
